Bethel Church Council Minutes

October 16, 2023

Call to Order 7:00 pm by President Norman Brown.



Members Present: President Norman Brown, Vice President Larry Wieckhorst, Building and Grounds Representative Josh Epp, Member-at-Large Brian Ried, Financial Representative Jason Holman, Rick Shallenberger and Board Secretary Nancy Brown. Also present were Pastor Jacob Colligan, Memorial Officer Margaret Brust and Financial Officer Sandy Ried. Also, present Micheal Wieckhorst President of Spiritual Council and Building and Grounds and Michelle Francis, Board of Christian Education President.

Motion made by Jason and seconded by Larry to go into Executive Session. Passed.

After Executive Session, Pastor Jacob Colligan opened with prayer.

Jason moved and Rick seconded to accept agenda, passed.

No Members Comments at this time.

Nancy presented last months meeting minutes, Larry moved and Rick seconded to approve without changes, passed.

Financial Report was made available for review by members. Sandy presented members with the current liability insurance policy. The premium will cost an additional \$3,100 starting January, for a total of \$16,000 a year. Brian volunteered to look into another company. September showed a deficient of \$5,470. Josh moved with Jason seconding to pay the bills, passed.

Norm reported that Mary Thiesfeld-Hickey resigned last week as Church Secretary. Nancy has requested we increase our efforts to find a replacement.

Nancy, serving as Church Secretary, brought to the Boards attention that the list of persons that have metal keys is not complete. Requests for information to update the list has not been effective. The keys are a master key. Nancy expressed her concern about the number of people that have access to the Church office. It was decided to rekey the Church and mark them for accountability. Sandy presented the 2023 Liability Policy to be kept in the Church office.

Margaret, Memorial Officer reported the account balance is \$89,467.12. No changes in the CDs since annual report. Website donation is yet to paid. The microphone has been purchased as an honorarium for Pastor Keith.

Mike reported that Spiritual Council will meet tomorrow night. The Board is asking if the Council has considered Rev Jacob Colligan to serve as our Interim. That question will be addressed under New Business. The Board will be calling inactive members to evaluate their status.

Michelle reported that the new Sunday School format seems to be working well. They had 13 kids the first week and 5 last week. Carrie Ferguson, Erin Johnson and Danielle Barrett are working with the Confirmation class. Mentors will be leading the classes; sermon reports will be due twice a month. The Christmas Program is planned for December 17th as a musical. They will be asking the Choir Director for assistance. December 3rd is Hanging of the Greens. Trunk or Treat plans are going well. The confirmands are running the games and the Women's Fellowship will be serving the Hot Dogs. The Thanksgiving Dinner is scheduled for November 12th and their next meeting will be November 20th.

Buildings and Grounds Chairmen Michael Wieckhorst. The Roof repair is awaiting insurance approval.

Church Council Meeting, October 16th cont.

The crack in the wall will be complete by the committee after harvest. He has contacted two companies for estimates on replacement of current nonfunctioning locking system. Its looking like the cost will be \$8,000 for 2 locking doors (the North Door and the basement door), key fob system, cameras at the doors and hall with recording capacities. It is recommended to replace the North Door at this time. The cost will raise 7% after January. He visited with Eric Madson regarding the replacement of the lighting in the Basement. The LED lights cost \$40-\$75, for a total of \$2,940. Larry motioned to present to the Congregation a request to update the Basement Lights with Memorial money. Josh seconded and passed.

Michelle reported for the Bethel Team. The Turkey Trot event is scheduled for November 18th with registration at 8:15 and the race starting at 9:00. The Living Nativity is planned for Saturday, December 16th and 23rd. We will be working with the Creative District in Nebraska City to present it on the 22nd.

Search Committee – David Carpenter has stepped away for the committee, Brian Ried has agreed to replace him on the committee. Motion was made by Larry and seconded by Jason to accept Brian on the committee. Stephen Luther has accepted the role of Chairman and Brenda Wieckhorst will serve as Secretary. They will meet every two weeks.

Old Business

Church Security - Note Building and Grounds report.

Social Media – Brian reported that the Website and Email are both working, currently working on fixing Facebook account. Our old website needs to be removed as its blocking the access to the new one. Brian can remove with the authorization from the Board. Rick moved with Larry's second to remove the old website from the web, motion passed. The g-mail mail system will be set to redirect the mail to our new account and a signature line be added. To live stream the Sunday Service and Weekly message and on-line giving capability will cost \$999 per year to set up and an additional \$222 - \$277.99 a month to run. Will put this project on hold at this time.

Sound System – The new mike has been ordered. Still waiting on the monitor for the Choir.

Non-Wedding Church Usage Agreement- Rick moved and Nancy seconded that this should be moved to the next Working Council Meeting, passed.

North Door proposal- Jason moved and Rick seconded to move forward with the replacement of the North Doors with possible Memorial money. Passed. This will be brought to the congregation for approval.

2024 Budget Approval Meeting is planned for October 22.

New Business

Norm reported that this Board held an interview with Pastor Jacob Colligan for the position of Interim Pastor. Jason moved to offer Pastor Jacob a 6-month contract to serve as our Interim Pastor starting November 1st. Larry seconded and the motion passed. Pastor Jacob accepted.

Church Council Meeting, October 16th cont. After no new business, Larry and Jason moved the meeting be closed, passed. The Lord's Prayer was recited. Next Council Meeting November 20, 2023 at 7pm.




